

**MESQUITE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**  
**Uniform Dress Code**  
**2019-2020**

- **Tops:** Solid navy blue, light blue, and white collared shirts and blouses. Mesquite t-shirts, hoodies, and jackets can be purchased from PTO through the school office.
  
- **Bottoms:** Blue or khaki pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers, dresses, and capris are allowed, as well as dark blue denim jeans and shorts. Shorts, skirts, skorts, dresses, and jumpers need to be at least fingertip length when arms are at one's side. Shorts are to be worn under skirts and dresses. *Leggings alone are not allowed.*
  
- **Socks:** Any color socks may be worn. White, blue, or beige tights or leggings need to be worn with skirts. Short shorts with leggings or tights are not allowed.
  
- **Shoes:** Closed shoes need to be worn on PE days. Low-heeled sandals with back strap are permitted but flip-flops, slippers, and hee-lies are not.
  
- **Outerwear:** Any color jacket, sweater, or sweatshirt is permitted outside and if worn inside, must be unzipped or unbuttoned to show the school uniform. Mesquite hoodies are allowed in doors.
  
- **Hats:** Hats and hoods are permitted outside, not inside.
  
- **Other:** Artificial nails, make-up, and hair that is dyed an unnatural color are not permitted, per district code. The Casa Grande Elementary School dress code is J-2361, JICA-R.

A student's family will be contacted to bring a change of clothing if the student is not in uniform and if alternative wear is not available in the office. If a student wears alternative clothing for the day, the family is to launder and return the clothing to the office.
