Graduate Hours Approval Committee Criteria for Approval of Graduate Courses for District Salary Credit

- 1. Approval will be granted only if requested prior to beginning the course.
- 2. Approval will be granted for graduate level courses, which involve rigorous, in-depth training and support District goals. Credit is not available for undergraduate courses or for District staff development workshops.
- 3. The training must provide direct and tangible benefits to instruction. A description of such benefits must be provided in all requests for credit, as well as a plan for implementing instructional improvements.
- 4. No salary credit will be available for training that a teacher is paid to attend through District non-grant funds, nor for graduate coursework when tuition is paid through District or grant sources. If training occurs during the workday, salary credit is not available.
- 5. Transcripts or grade reports must be submitted at the conclusion of the courses.
- 6. Individuals employed as special education teachers, who possess provisional, standard elementary, or standard secondary certificates, may receive salary credit for approved graduate hours taken to fulfill the requirements of the special education certificate.
- 7. Salary credit will only be awarded for graduate level courses that provide a direct benefit to the District or to an employee's current job function. In the event the employee transfers to a position in which such coursework would be of value to the District, the employee may submit a request for credit to the Graduate Hours Approval Committee.
