

Damaged and Lost Device Fines 2022-2023

In June 2022, the CGESD Governing Board approved the suspension of the Device Protection Plan (DPP) for the 2022-2023 school year. ESSER III funding has been set aside by the district in lieu of providing a Device Protection Plan to offset costs to our families.

The approximate cost to the district for the repairs and fines that will be charged are listed below:

Fines will be assessed based on an assessment of damage by a CGESD IT Technician and reported to the school site.

The school site will inform parents/guardians of any fines incurred by their child as soon as it is determined. Invoices will be provided by the school site to the parent/guardian.
